Witness Information:

- **Medical Power of Attorney and Will and Testament:** Just need two witnesses to sign.
- **Durable, General and Limited Power of Attorney:** Need 2 witnesses and a Notary to sign.

Who can be a witness:

- A legal adult (over the age of 18)
- A neutral third party (someone who is not involved in the document/transaction)
- Can confirm the identity of the signer.
- Has the mental capacity to make decisions without assistance.
